October - December	On-campus recruitment and interviews
January 15	Applications and collateral materials due
March 15	Acceptance / notification letters sent out to applicants
May (3 <sup>rd</sup> week)	Mandatory intern orientation
May (3 <sup>rd</sup> & 4 <sup>th</sup> week)	Proposed start date for internship (this will vary depending on your last day of class)
